This will ensure you have a broad range of subjects. German can be one of these options. In Technologies you cannot choose two Business courses or two HE courses. In Expressive arts you cannot choose two PE course. Once you have chosen from the Curriculum areas below, see if your choices fit the column options on the next page. You may also wish to choose a college option (see back page) in place of one of your four options (not in place of English or Maths). If you choose a college option you will still need four choices in case you are unsuccessful in gaining a college place. Remember, you will be expected to take your five best subjects at the end of Fourth Year into Fifth Year.
