Construction & Engineering SCQF Level 4

Course Info/Aim: Candidates will study a range of construction areas to gain an insight into the skills, experiences and demands of the construction industry.

National Progression Award Cosmetology SCQF Level 4

Course Info/Aim: Candidates will study a range of Hairdressing and Beauty areas to gain an insight into the skills and demands of the Hair & Beauty industry.

SVQ1 in Food Preparation & Cooking SCQF Level 4

Course Info/Aim: Candidates will study a range of catering topics to gain an insight into the skills, experiences and demands of the catering industry.

Skills for Work - Early Education and Childcare SCQF Level 4

Course Info/Aim: Candidates will study the development of children from birth to young adulthood and study a range of factors affecting this development. The candidates gain an insight into the early education and childcare provision available for children and give them an understanding of the requirements; the last unit will give candidates an insight into the early education and childcare provision available for children and give them an understanding of the requirement.

Skills for Work - Health Sector and Health Social Care Higher Intermediate 1 (SCQF Level 4)

Course Info/Aim: Candidates will study a range of factors affecting the Health Sector. Candidates gain an insight into roles, responsibilities, skills and give them an understanding of the requirements of working within this dynamic environment.

Skills for Work - Sport and Recreation Intermediate 1 (SCQF Level 4)

Course Info/Aim: Candidates will study a range of factors affecting Sport and Recreation. Candidates gain an insight into roles, responsibilities; skills needed and give them an understanding of the requirements of working within this environment. With Glasgow 2014 Commonwealth Games less than 2 years ago and opportunities to engage with many sporting events, it is an exciting time to engage in Sport and Recreation.

SQA Employability Units SCQF Levels 3 & 4 (depending on ability)

Course Info/Aim: The Employability Award is an introduction to the world of work for those who are unsure about how to gain and sustain employment. It is available at SCQF level 3 and level 4. The Course focuses on generic employability skills, to enable a successful move into the job market. Candidates will develop skills and attitudes which will be applicable across all areas of employment.

ESOL (English for Speakers of Other Languages) SCQF Level 3

Course Info/Aim: The main purpose of the course is to develop the skills of reading, writing, listening, and speaking in order to improve comprehension and delivery for learners whose first language is not English.

As learners develop their language skills, they will be able to process information more easily, apply knowledge of language in practical and relevant contexts, and gain confidence to carry out new and more challenging tasks in a variety of situations.

SQA Volunteering Award SCQF Levels 3, 4 & 5 (depending on ability)

Course Info/Aim: These units will be available either individually or as the full award. Completion of these will help learners gather evidence of their volunteering experience and satisfy requirements for progression to further or higher education, further volunteering or employment.

Skills for Work - Engineering Skills Intermediate 2

Course Info/Aim: Candidates will study a range of engineering areas to gain an insight into the skills, experiences and demands of the engineering industry.

Fashion and Textiles SCQF Level 4

Course Info/Aim: This programme introduces pupil to the design process with a Fashion and Textiles context. It will develop concepts and ideas, drawing skills and introduce you to various textiles techniques that are used in Fashion and Textile Art.
